

# Easter Chicken

**Yarn:** Scheepjes – Catona or Svarta Fåret – Tilda, Järbo garn – Nova.

**Hook:** 2,5mm

**Measure:** 4cm high.

## Abbreviations (US)

ch – chain

sl st – slip stitch

sc – single crochet

hdc – half double crochet

dc – double crochet

tr – treble crochet

## Good to know

- The chicken is crocheted in two rows.
- When you are done and attaching the ends, sew together the stitches by the head to remove any cavities.

**1:** ch5, 1sl st to make a circle. Ch2, 7dc around the circle, ch3.

**2:** Skip the first chain, 2sl st.

**3:** 1sl st in the front loop and through the top thread of the double crochet.



**4:** 1dc around the circle.

**5:** 3ch3, skip the stitch closest to the needle, 2sl st. 1sl st in the front loop and through the top thread of the double crochet.

**6:** 3dc around the circle, ch1.



**7:** 1tr, 3dc, 1hdc around the circle, 1sl st in the first double crochet of the circle.

**8:** In the next stitch the head is made: 1sc, 2hdc, 3dc.

**9:** ch1, 1sl st in the front loop and through the top thread of the double crochet. 2dc, skip one stitch, 1sm in the next.
