

# Easter rooster

**Yarn:** Scheepjes – Catona or for example Svarta Fåret – Tilda, Järbo garn – Nova.

**Color:** White, red and orange.

**Hook:** 2,5mm

## Abbreviations (US)

ch – chain

sl st – slip stitch

sc – single crochet

hdc – half double crochet

dc – double crochet

## Good to know

- When you are done and attaching the ends sew together the stitches by the head to remove any cavities.

## Start with white yarn.

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**1:** ch4, 1sl st in the first to make a circle. Ch2, 16dc around the circle, 1sl st in the first stitch.

**2:** In the next dc: 1sl st, ch6, 1sc in the second from the needle, 1hdc in the next three stitches, 1sl st in the last of the six chains.

**3:** Repeat the second point two more times.



**4:** Skip one stitch, 1sl st in the next four stitches.

**5:** ch2, 6dc, ch2, 1sl st in the same stitch. Cut of the thread and weave in the ends.



**Continue with red yarn.**

**6:** In the four center stitches on the rooster's head: 1sl st i the right one.

**7:** ch3, 1sl st in the next stitch, ch2, 1sl st in the next stitch.

**8:** ch3, 1sl st in the fourth stitch. Cut off the thread and weave in the ends.



**9:** The "bag" under the chin is made in red yarn in the stitch between the head and the body that the needle points to.

**10:** 1sl st, ch3. Cut of the yarn, fold the chain towards the back – like a circle – and weave in the ends.



**Continue with orange yarn.**

**11:** The beak is done in the same way as the bag, in the stitch just above. Repeat therefore point 10 once.

**12:** Turn it upside down and find the two middle stitches, where the feet are made. 1sl st in the right stitch, ch4, 1sl st in the same stitch.

**13:** 1sl st in the next stitch, ch4, 1sl st in the same stitch. Cut off the thread and weave in the ends.
