

The Emelie bag

Yarn: Scheepjes Bloom, 3 skeins á 50g.

Hook: 5mm

Abbreviations (US)

ch - chain

sl st - slip stitch

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

tr – trebble crochet

Ch6, 1sl st in the first stitch to make a circle.

1: ch3, 20tr around the circle, skip the three chains in the beginning of the row, 1sl st in the first trebble crochet.

2: ch4, (1tr, ch1) x19.

End with a slip stitch in the third of the four chains in the beginning of the row.

3: ch3, 2tr around the chain space (1tr in the next stitch, 2tr around the chain space) x19.

End with a slip stitch in the third chain in the beginning of the row.

4: ch4, skip 1 stitch, (1tr in the next stitch, ch1, skip 1 stitch) x29

End with a slip stitch in the third of the four chains in the beginning of the row.

Från och med nu kommer cirkelns kanter luta inåt och arbetet blir som en skål.

5: ch3, (1tr around the chain space, 1tr in the next stitch, 1tr around the chain space, 1tr in the next stitch, 2tr around the chain space, 1tr in the next stitch) x9.

1tr around the chain space, 1tr in the next stitch, 1tr around the chain space, 1tr in the next stitch, 2tr around the next chain space.

End with a slip stitch in the third chain in the beginning of the row.

6: ch4, skip 1 stitch (1tr in the next stitch, ch2, skip 1 stitch, 1tr in the next stitch, ch1) x17.

End with a slip stitch in the third of the four chains in the beginning of the row.

7: ch3, 1tr around the next chain space (1tr in the next stitch, 2tr around the next chain space, 1tr in the next stitch, 1tr around the next chain space) x17.

End with a slip stitch in the third chain in the beginning of the row.

8: ch4 (skip 1 stitch, 1tr in the next stitch, ch1) x43.

End with a slip stitch in the third of the four chains in the beginning of the row.

9: ch3, 1tr around the next chain space (1tr in the next stitch, 1tr around the next chain space) x43.

End with a slip stitch in the third chain in the beginning of the row.

10-16: Repeat row 8 and 9.

17-20: ch1, 1hdc in every stitch.

End with a slip stitch in the chain in the beginning of the row.

21: ch4, skip 3 stitches, 1sc (ch3, skip 3 stitches, 1sc) x20. Ch3, skip 3 stitches.

End with a slip stitch in the first chain in the beginning of the row.

22: 1 skip stitch around the chain space, ch1, 3hdc around the same chain space (4hsc around the next chain space) x21.

End with a slip stitch in the chain in the beginning of the row.

23: ch1.

Turn the work and crochet the rest of the row from wrong side.

(1dc, 1sl st) x44.

Cut of the yarn and fasten the thread.



Shoulder-strap – green bag

Chain 102.

1: 1dc in the fourth stitch from the needle, 1dc in the remaining stitch.

2: ch1 (1dc, 1sl st) x50.

Ch1, turn the work 90 degrees to the right, 1sl st around the chain.

Turn the work ones more 90 degrees to the right and continue working on the underside.

3: 1sl st in the first stitch, ch1. (1dc, 1sl st) x50.

Cut the thread and sew both ends of the band, evenly, on the inside of the upper edge of the bag.



Shoulder-strap – gray bag

Chain 5.

1: 1sc in the second stitch from the needle. 3sc. *Turn.*

2: ch1, 4sc. *Turn.*

Repeat row two to the desired length, I made 70 rows. Keep in mind that the straps will be longer after a little use.

Make three more in the same way. Sew one end of each strap, even, on the top of the bag. Put the straps together, with a knot at the other end. If the straps would be too long, make a knot with all four straps, a little bit below the first knots.



Tie strap

Make 140 chains (or the number you think will make a good length) and cut the thread. Tie the strap between the holes on row 21.

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
